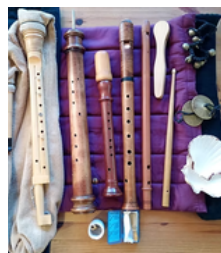

Lizzie Gutteridge on her Bike

Following Pearl in the Egg's wonderfully characterful early-instrument recital in April, Mancroft Music welcomes another performer on **18th July at 1.00pm** who will be bringing historical music vividly to life.



Lizzie Gutteridge's solo project, *Fortune's Wheel, Consort of 1*, combines early music on historical instruments with live-looping: a technique in which short musical phrases are recorded and repeated during the performance, allowing one musician to build up several layers of sound. In this way, Lizzie can reveal Medieval and Renaissance melodies from a fresh and unexpected perspective.

Lizzie has been travelling to concerts across East Anglia by bamboo bicycle - and, where necessary, public transport - with a compact pannier-full of instruments including recorder, chalumeau, bagpipe, sordune, small percussion and voice.

Lizzie plays a wide range of historical instruments and has performed at Shakespeare's Globe, Hampton Court, the Tower of London and the National Gallery.

This promises to be a fascinating, unusual and highly engaging recital.
